Welcome to The Scholarships 4 Us® Senior Program. High school seniors will have the opportunity to compete in a series of competitions before graduation over a predetermined time period in which each event you will accrue savings and have the opportunity to accumulate Prize Funds if you place **Top 5**. There will be **25** entrants in every Accredited Event and the **Cost of Entry** for each event can be found on the 'Program Financials' page of the Senior Program. The Cost of Entry is divided into three categories:

25%- Savings Contribution

25%- Expense and Lineage

50%- Prize Funds

Scholarships 4 Us®, LLC is the Legislative-Compliance enterprise for potential collegiate athletes and students. The Scholarships 4 Us® Program maintains Amateurism compliance by ensuring Prize Funds are disbursed as a Scholarship Award for students that are planning to participate in collegiate athletics for the NCAA®, NJCAA®, NAIA®, or NACE®. The collegiate athletic associations have jurisdiction over potential collegiate athletes from accepting Prize Money so if you are not going to participate in collegiate athletics you have the option to request your accumulated Prize Funds as Prize Money or a Scholarship Award. ALL students that are competitive are encouraged to enroll and participate so that you will have a source of funding either for school or life when you graduate.

How The Scholarships 4 Us® Senior Program Works

According to IRS Topic No. 421; a scholarship is non-taxable so long the amount received is used for enrollment at an educational institution or for necessary supplies for a course at the educational institution. The amount of accumulated prize funds you earn through the series of Accredited Events can be disbursed directly to your educational institution as a Scholarship Award. The objective of The Scholarships 4 Us® Senior Program is to provide high school seniors the opportunity to earn scholarship funds before leaving for school.

When a student enrolls in The Scholarships 4 Us® Senior Program they will establish an **ESA (Earning and Savings Account)** that is assigned to an **Enrollment ID** that will permit them to purchase tickets to our upcoming events once they submit their Enrollment Requirements on the Scholarships 4 Us® website. This will allow us to keep track record of event participation, accrued savings, and accumulated prize funds which is managed within the Members' Account on the Scholarships 4 Us® website and in the S4Us.portal™.

Students must meet the following eligibility criterion in order to participate in The Scholarships 4 Us® Senior Program:

- ✚ A current high school senior that is enrolled in a U.S. Charter, Home, Public or Private Educational Institution*
- ✚ Be of age within the Eligibility Time Period
 - A students Eligibility Time Period begins the day of a students' **12th Birthday** and **expires May 31st** their senior year of high school.
- ✚ Graduating in 2025
- ✚ If under 18, the student must have a Parent, Legal Guardian, or Authorized Representative present at the time of enrollment to sign and agree to the 'Parent, Legal Guardian or Authorized Representative Rights and Responsibilities' Form and ensure that the potential Student-Participant has consent to sign the 'Student-Participant Rights and Responsibilities' Form
- ✚ Sign and agree to the 'Student-Participant Rights and Responsibilities'

*International Exchange or Study Aboard Students are not eligible to enroll



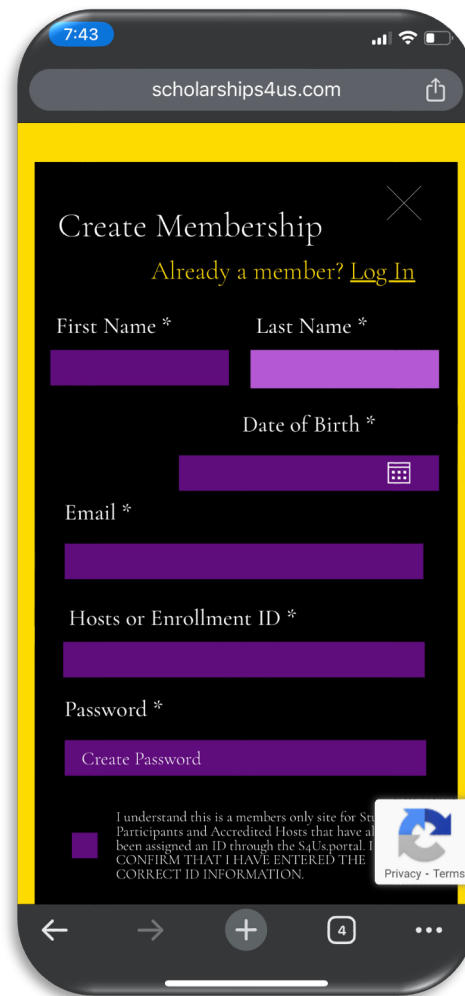
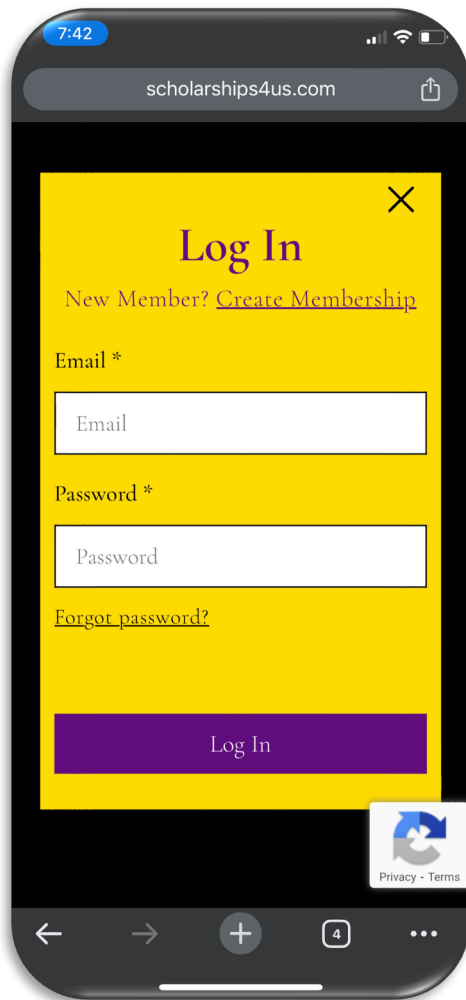
Scholarships 4 Us®
The Rule of Amateurism™

A student is eligible to enroll and maintain enrollment in The Scholarships 4 Us® Program *only if*:

- 1. The student has not entered into a verbal or expressed agreement with an agent(s) that may financially profit from their participation, performance, or place finish in a competition or tournament in The Arts, Sports, or Esports
- 2. The student has not participated in a professional tryout or signed with a professional team
- 3. The student has not accepted any remuneration for participating in a competition or tournament
- 4. The student has not accepted prize money based on place finish in a competition or tournament
- 5. The student has not agreed to, signed, or received benefits from an NIL (Name, Image, and Like) deal or contract



- Go to www.Scholarships4Us.com/Enrollment and select 'Caspio' or the 'Enrollment Form'
- Complete the form and submit it to Enrollment@Scholarships4Us.com in .PDF format with verification of Enrollment which can be either a copy of your current Student ID or Class Schedule.
Use the **Subject Line**- 'Enrollment: (Last Name, First Name (DOB)).'
- Once eligibility is determined then an email will be sent with your Enrollment ID and a link to submit your Enrollment Requirements at www.Scholarships4Us.com/Membership. Once submitted, you will have established your ESA (Earning and Savings Account) that allows us to keep track record of your event participation, accumulated Prize Funds and Savings Contributions. You will be required to enter your Enrollment ID at checkout when purchasing tickets to events. At the end of each event you will provide your Enrollment ID to the Accredited Hosts.



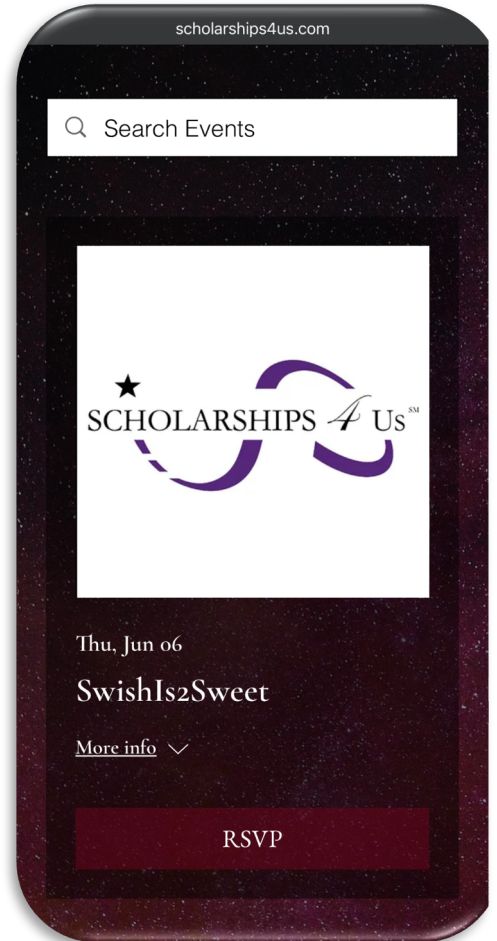
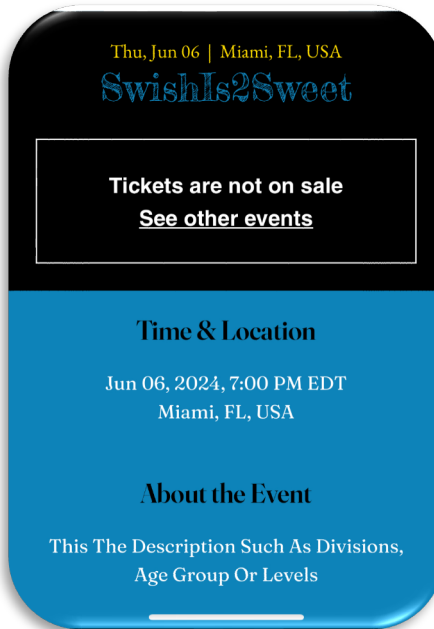
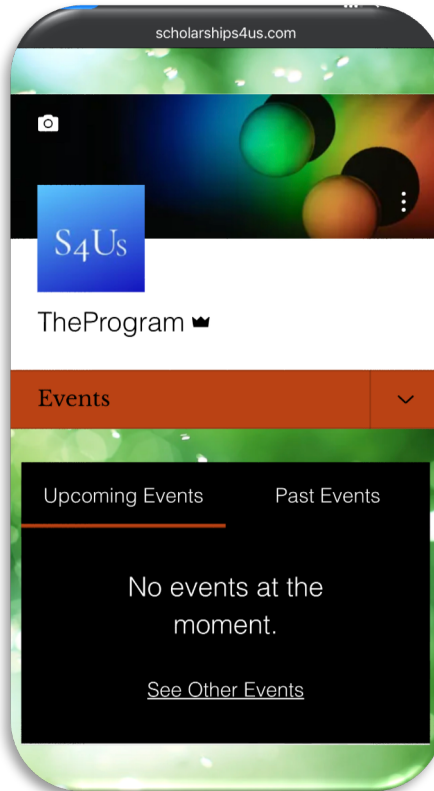

Legislative-Compliance

Scholarships 4 Us® maintains records of participation, accrued savings, and accumulated prize funds in each event and the disbursement of the funds on behalf of our Student-Participants.

Each weeks report will consist of the 'Close an Event' Form and ESA statement.

- ◆ ESA Disbursement Request are to be received by **11:59PM** Eastern Standard Time **June 30th** the year of high school graduation. The Disbursement Request Form should be emailed in .PDF format to Accounts@Scholarships4Us.com with the **Subject Line-** ' Disbursement Request (Enrollment ID)'
- ◆ Processing of disbursements is scheduled from **July 1st – July 31st**
- ◆ All disbursements* are mailed out annually on **August 1st** in two separate checks

1. Savings Contributions

- a. DISBURSEMENT IS MAILED DIRECTLY TO THE FORMER STUDENT-PARTICIPANT

2. Scholarship Award

(Must be used per IRS Topic. 421)

- a. NON-TAXABLE INCOME
- b. MUST PROVIDE VERIFICATION OF ENROLLMENT (Class Schedule, Financial Aid Award Letter or Student ID)
- c. DISBURSEMENT IS MAILED DIRECTLY TO THE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION

3. Prize Money

- a. TAXABLE INCOME
- b. POTENTIAL COLLEGIATE STUDENT-ATHLETES MUST REPORT ACCEPTED PRIZE MONEY ON THEIR ELIGIBILITY QUESTIONNAIRE. THE NCAA®, NAIA®, NACE®, OR NJCAA® MAY RULE IN VIOLATION OF THEIR AMATEURISM STATUS
- c. DISBURSEMENT IS MAILED DIRECTLY TO THE FORMER STUDENT-PARTICIPANT

*Records of disbursements are available upon request to the IRS, NCAA®, NAIA®, NJCAA®, NACE® or postsecondary educational institutions in order to maintain our commitment to being the Legislative-Compliance enterprise

1. Tickets go on sale **24-Hours** prior to the start of an event and close **1-Hour** prior to the start time
2. All ticket sales are **FINAL** and **NON-REFUNDABLE**
3. Each ticket must be purchased individually using the Student-Participants name, email, and Enrollment ID
4. Only **1-ticket** purchase is permissible **per** participant **per** event
5. Taxation will be **PAID BY THE BUYER** according to national, state and/or local applicable laws
6. A Wix Service Fee applies at **2.5%** and is **PASSED ON TO THE BUYER**
7. Tickets will be emailed and the QR Code can be scanned at check-in
8. A Student-Participant that is unable to attend the event will **FORFEIT** their prize fund, expense and lineage, but will be **CREDITED** their Savings Contribution.
